Introduction

Many SWM members from communities, business and local authorities have been approached and offered 'free' photovoltaic panels. We asked our associates Matthew Rhodes and Jon Morris and authors of our recent retrofit and finance report for their advice on the key questions to help you make informed decisions about the provider's offer.

Key Questions to Ask Your 'Free' Provider of Photovoltaic Panels

1. What is the expertise and track record of the developer? How much experience do they have in each of the following and how will they manage it for your project?

- a. Securing finance
- b. Solar technology
- c. Project management including site selection and surveying
- d. Local procurement
- e. Training and developing local supply chains
- f. Ongoing operations and maintenance over 25 years
- g. Managing tenants and/or local community relations
- h. Housing projects
- 2. How are risks shared and managed in the project for each of the following?
 - a. Project development and planning risk
 - b. Project delivery
 - c. Ongoing operations and maintenance
 - d. Security and insurances
 - e. Product warranties
 - f. Energy price fluctuations/market and regulatory risks
- 3. Where does the finance come from?
 - a. Is it directly from the project developer or lent from other funds?
 - b. What contribution is required from the community/property owners?
- 4. Who owns what?
 - a. Do the developers plan to sell the project on once it is operational?
 - b. What happens if the underlying properties are sold?
 - c. What happens if individual systems get broken, vandalised or otherwise stop working?
- 5. What are the financials and assumptions?
 - a. What are the income streams and who gets what and why?
 - b. Is there scope to use benefits from PV to support other low carbon work locally?

6. Why are the providers better than other potential offers in your area led by your local authority or registered social landlord?
